The National VA Council VBA Mid-Term Bargaining Committee is formally requesting to bargain on the appropriate arrangements for any adversely affected employee as a result of the newly implemented RVSR Virtual Training that began in Boise, Ft. Harrison, Phoenix, Reno, San Diego, and Seattle this month.

We request that a briefing be scheduled, and all data considered to come to the determination of implementing such a program, be provided to the committee prior to the briefing. This should include the briefing packet, memorandums, rollout plan, and statistics as to impact expected on quality of training.

We request that further implementation be deferred until all required negotiations are completed per the Master Agreement and the statute.
