

Dear Mr. Williams:

1. In accordance with the Master Agreement between the Department of Veterans Affairs and AFGE, Article 47, Section 4 (B), please find attached the summary for the Post-Ramp Parking Plan.
2. The parties have been participating in pre-decisional discussions. On December 13, 2013 a Demand to Bargain the post-ramp parking was issued by AFGE Locals 1969 and 3669 to the MVAHCS Director. The summary referenced above contains the breakdown regarding concurrence and non-concurrence on the post-ramp parking recommendations.
3. The ramp is scheduled to open in the near future and it is very important that the few outstanding issues are resolved.
