

Dear Mr. Williams:

1. In accordance with the Master Agreement between the Department of Veterans Affairs and AFGE, Article 47, Section 4 (B), please find attached the proposal to implement the Trans-Aortic Valve Replacement (TAVR) Procedures using the Cardiac Cath Lab.
2. The purpose of this proposal is to begin doing TAVR procedures in the Cath lab until the new Hybrid ORs are completed. The staff impacted by this proposal are the Cath Lab Staff, OR staff, and ICU staff. In addition to training, these procedures may impact tours and on-call.
3. The planned implementation date for performing these procedures in the Cath Lab will be in approximately 2-3 months. It is proposed that these procedures will be done in the Cardiac Cath Lab until the completion of the Hybrid ORs (1-2 years). The lead negotiator for this proposal, should you request to bargain, will be Sue LeSuer. Sharon Myllenbeck, Julie Wagner and Teresa Tungseth will also be on the negotiating team. Don Wodek will be the Human Resources advisor.
