Through the national grievance process outlined in Article 43, Section 11 of the Master Agreement between the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) and the American Federation of Government Employees (AFGE) (2011) (Master Agreement), the American Federation of Government Employees/National Veterans Affairs Council (Union) and VA have reached a settlement of the above referenced grievance.

The VA shall provide 20 hours of official time to Mr. William Jefferson, extending his period of 100% official time from June 30, 2015 to July 7, 2015. In exchange, the Union has agreed to withdraw NG-3/13/2015.
