On February 12, 2018, NVAC filed a National Grievance against the Agency for failing to satisfy national bargaining obligations prior to implementing the Veteran Eligibility Review SharePoint Pilot (“VERS”) in CPAC facilities nationwide. Subsequently, the VHA Office of Community Care - Performance Improvement & Reporting ceased implementation of the VERS Pilot. Per our discussion, the Agency agrees to provide proper notice to NVAC and satisfy national bargaining obligations prior to reimplementing the VERS Pilot.
