Subject: Truman VA - PIV Proximity Card Update

In accordance with Article 47 Section 4A the following policy is being routed to NVAC.

Justification to support change: Harry S Truman VA Hospital has upgraded all Proximity Cards to PIV Card only, as part of the National Upgrade Program (HSPD-12). All employees must have their PIV Card and pin number readily accessible in order to transition to PIV proximity cards. Bargaining unit employees will be required to visit to the VA Police Department with their PIV Card to get their card registered. Bargaining unit employees will have their same previously granted logical access.

Who is affected: Bargaining unit employees from Local 903 (Professional) and Local 3399 (Non Professional) working conditions are affected.

Proposed implementation date: June 1, 2015 or as soon as the negotiations has been completed.

How will they be affected: There are no changes to bargaining unit employees working condition. Bargaining unit employees will have their same previous logical access. Bargaining unit employees will be required to visit to the VA Police Department with their PIV Card to get their cards registered.
