



Memorandum of Understanding

The following constitutes an agreement between the Department of Veterans Affairs, Veterans Health Administration (VHA) and the American Federation of Government Employees, (AFL-CIO), National Veterans Affairs Council #53 on VHA Handbook 1140.47 Geriatric Patient Aligned Care Team (GeriPACT).


1. The national parties agree the GeriPACT team consists of the GeriPACT provider, a registered nurse, a social worker, a Clinical Pharmacist, a clinical associate (generally a licensed vocational nurse, licensed practical nurse, or health technician) and clerical staff.
2. The parties agree the full-time panel size of a physician geriatric provider must not exceed 2/3 of the panel capacity set for the facility's physician PCPs. For non-physician geriatric providers, the pro-rated full-time panel size must not exceed 2/3 the panel capacity set for the facility's independent non-physician PCPs.
3. The parties agree that Interdisciplinary GeriPACT teamlet members need to be physically present in the clinic during clinic hours.
4. AFGE Locals may request to bargain on the local implementation of this VHA Handbook so long as there is no conflict with this MOU.
5. Upon their receipt the appropriate management officials shall provide a copy of this MOU to the AFGE Local President.
