Missouri Veterans Affairs Union Members to Hold Kansas City Car Caravan Protest Demanding Senator Hawley's Resignation

Protest Comes After Sen. Hawley Instigated Insurrection at the U.S. Capitol on January 6

Kansas City - Members of American Federation of Government Employees (AFGE) Locals 96, 2192, 2338, and 85 along with other labor groups, clergy and supporters will come together on Saturday, January 30th to demand the resignation of Senator Josh Hawley for instigating the January 6 insurrection at the U.S. Capitol. AFGE, fellow protest participants and the people of Missouri have unequivocally denounced his behavior and demanded his resignation from the Senate effective immediately.

Participants will protest in Kansas City via car-a-van to ensure social distancing is maintained, and local AFGE members and other participants will be available for media interviews. Protests demanding Hawley's resignation were also held in St. Louis and Cape Girardeau last Wednesday.
